PROJECT OVERVIEW

VET Coordinators, Trainers and Operators from Partner organisations are invited to apply to participate in the Learning Teaching Training Activity (C1) which will be organised by the [Europe Atelier of Crafts -Cr.E.Ate](#) Partnership in April 2018.

Cr.E.Ate is an EU funded project (Erasmus+, KA2 - Strategic Partnership for vocational education and training) of VET institutions aimed at promoting work-based learning, designing and testing a flexible and sustainable learning process, based on the integration between innovation and tradition.

In response to the selected priorities and recommendations related to the EU policies and initiatives, CR.E.ATE aims to involve European VET providers to foster the relevant and high quality skills and competencies in order to promote employability, professional and social development of those learners (above all youth less qualified) who need to be integrated into the labor market.

CR.E.ATE partners will co-create and test an innovative Training Module, a combination of innovation and tradition, which supports European learners to have (international) work-based learning experience, providing chances for their personal and professional growth.

Cr.E.Ate is focused on the following LTTAs:

- C1: 1st International Training Workshop: Guidelines of the “Atelier of Jobs” Model (Label)
- 2nd International Training Workshop (C2): Pilot of the “Atelier of Jobs” Model

Cr.E.Ate intends providing conceptual guidelines, methodological and practical development of a *Atelier model Crafts* to be shared and transferred to other European countries through an exchange of ideas, experiences and good practice. The project LTTAs (C1 and C2) intend to evaluate the results achieved, detect weaknesses and potential for development with the common goal of reducing the European gap between demand and supply of labour and to increase the level of employability.

Project Goals:

1. Creation and development of a **European Network of Crafts Ateliers** operating at transnational level aimed at sharing and comparing ideas, practices and methods based on agreed guidelines and procedures
2. Design the **Label** of the *Atelier of Jobs Model*
3. **Pilot** (Review of the Label)

CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS FOR C1

N. 15 VET Coordinators, Trainers and Operators of the Partner organisations (N.3 people from each Partner organisation) will share their views on the training needs to be considered for designing an innovative Training Module, a combination of innovation and tradition, which supports European learners to have (international) work-based learning experience, providing chances for their personal and professional growth.

The activities will be focused on co-creating the Methodological Guidelines (“Label”) of the Model of Atelier of Jobs that will be tested during C2 (Blended Mobility of VET Learners).

The programme consists of workshop Q&A sessions, roundtable discussions, debates and informal interaction with peers from Italy, Latvia, France, Poland and Spain.
